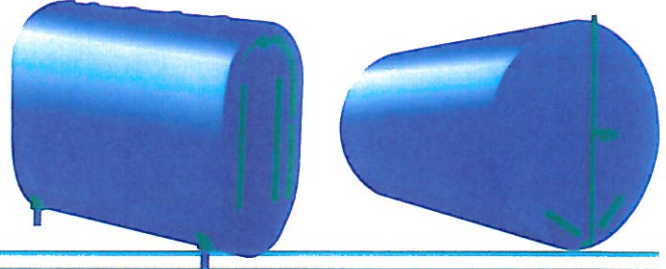

Customer Sign-up:

Customer Renewals:

Renewal notices are sent directly to the customer from the ProGuard office at least 60 days prior to the renewal date.
